How does the Lexington Medical Center Foundation assist patients and our community? Below are a few examples of support programs made possible by our generous donors

Cancer Care

Becky's Place is a boutique inside of our hospital that offers wigs, mastectomy bras and prosthetics for women recovering from breast cancer. With the help of WIRE (Women in Rural Electrification) the Foundation has provided wigs to over 7,500 women. The average cost for one wig is \$175.





Healing Icons is a program that facilitates healing through creative expression workshops for adult cancer survivors at no charge. This program activates the healing process and empowers survivors with new coping strategies.

Cardiovascular Care

Through full and partial scholarships the Foundation's **Cardiac Rehabilitation Fund** aids many individuals with rehabilitation services who could not otherwise afford the program. The cost of this program for one participant ranges from \$200 - \$500.



All open heart surgery patients receive a **healing heart pillow** that assists with recovery by helping with pain reduction during coughing, deep breathing and moving about. They are also used by physicians as diagrams to educate patients about their treatment.

Emergency Care



Teddy Bears are given to children and seniors to comfort them during Emergency events. "The bears have been given at the end of a visit as a reward. To some children it is a nice token; to those less fortunate their eyes sparkle as if they were receiving a present at Christmas. But the magic of the bears is not just for children. I had had several special needs adults who were silent and just staring into space that come alive when given a bear"—Dr. Don Moore
